

C/S ACROVYN - PROTECTING THE FUTURE AT WYNSTREAM PRIMARY SCHOOL, EXETER

Project Overview

C/S Acrovyn corner guards and crash rails are a very popular choice for use in schools and youth centres as they provide not only protection for the building, but also for those using it. In areas where high volumes of traffic occur, knocks and scrapes are inevitable, and Acrovyn helps to provide a safer environment for children whilst reducing the long-term maintenance costs of the building.

Wynstream Primary School was the first school delivered under the Exeter PFI programme. The exciting new facility replaces two existing schools; creating a bright, welcoming environment, suitable for both educational and community uses.

Two products from the C/S Acrovyn range were selected by Aedas architects. SCR50M crash rails were mounted at impact level in the corridors and dining area, and SM20 corner guards, at dado height, were fixed to corners. Both products, providing heavy duty protection, are suitable for use in main circulation areas.

The colour chosen for the wall protection, Pacific Blue, fits well with the vibrant colour scheme of the project.
