

TOP MARKS FOR C/S ACROVYN SHEET AT SANDON HIGH SCHOOL, STOKE ON TRENT



Project Overview

Sandon High School was one of the first new secondary schools in Stoke on Trent to be completed as part of the Building Schools for the Future programme. The staff and students moved into their new premises in February 2008 and quickly forged links with the surrounding community, opening up the schools facilities so that everyone can enjoy the benefits.



C/S Acrovyn impact protection Sheet in a 'Faux Wood' pattern was used on doors and lockers throughout the school. Simulated wood finishes were developed by C/S to withstand the abuse real wood can't handle. In addition they are so realistic there is no need to sacrifice durability for aesthetics.



The suede texture of the sheet protects surfaces from scuffs and scrapes, which frequently occur in the bustling, boisterous school environment. The appearance of minor damage is minimised by the scratch-resistant, through-colour sheet. Acrovyn clad doors will keep their look for longer, thus reducing the need for maintenance or replacement in the long-term.
